Insect Bite & Sting Prevention!

Did you know...

- **How to prevent being bitten or stung:**
 - Keep outdoor trash cans closed
 - Destroy nests with a commercial insect control aerosol
 - Spray from distance recommended on can
 - Avoid spraying on process equipment

Note: If allergic to bites/stings or if destroying nests will put you at significant risk, ask for assistance of a professional to destroy nests.
- **Should a bee, hornet or wasp fly near you:**
 - Slowly raise your arms to protect your face
 - Stand still or slowly move away from area
 - Never move rapidly (provokes an attack)
 - Never strike or swing at a wasp or bee which may provoke an attack. If crushed, a wasp has a chemical “alarm pheromone” which signals guard wasps to attack.

If bitten or stung, report to first aid for a medical evaluation – if allergic, see immediate medical care!
