Did You Know...

- Think about the “what if” and take action
- Protect by keeping out of harm’s way:
 - Heightened awareness by asking “What if some slips?”
 - Good communication with others
 - SOP’s use
- Protect through layers of protection:
 - Proper PPE appropriate to the hazard & job task
 - Proper tools for the job and trained to use them
 - Job skill & knowledge hazards
- Daily Activity ~ Good practices to follow!
 - Discuss the job scope and identify hazards with co-workers
 - Review tasks that will be performed in the workgroup so that everyone understands what they are doing.
 - If you are issuing a permit to help identify known hazards in the work area (e.g. hot equipment, critical equipment, protruding objects, etc.)
 - Insure you implement the controls of eliminations you identified during the pre-task hazard analysis process.
 - Use tools that eliminate potential line of fire hazards such as (tool holders, backup wrenches, flange alignment and spreader tools, etc...)
